1. Sample Size

We conducted a comprehensive Student Satisfaction Survey from the session 2023-24, focussing on student's experiences and feedbacks from the academic year 2024-25. Out of the 222 students enrolled in the college for the session, 70 students participated in the survey. This represents a participation rate of **31.53%**.



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

Q4. How do you rate the quality of teachers in your institution?


Analysis:

Screenshot of Pie Chart from Student Satisfaction Survey 2024-25


Q5. How much are you satisfied with all of your teacher's knowledge base?

Q. 17 Overall rating for the campus on a scale of ten: The average overall rating is **8.11 out of 10**. **67.1%** of students gave a rating in the **8-10** range and **24.3%** gave a decent rating of **6-7**, making it **91.4%**, confirming a high level of overall satisfaction with the institution.

Overall Student Satisfaction

The analysis of student feedback shows an overwhelmingly positive level of satisfaction with the institution. Satisfaction with teachers' knowledge base is exceptionally high, where **98.5%** of respondents are either *Highly Satisfied* or *Satisfied*, reflecting strong confidence in the academic competence of the faculty. Taken together, these results highlight that the majority of students are highly satisfied with the college's teaching quality, faculty expertise, and overall institutional experience.

Summary of Key Student Suggestions and Feedback

The following points summarise the main suggestions and feedback provided by the students, organised into key areas requiring attention:

1. Essential Infrastructure and Hygiene

This category highlights critical issues concerning basic student amenities:

- The **drinking water facility is not proper.**
- The **washrooms are a bit unclean.**

2. Extracurricular Activities and Sports Focus

This feedback emphasises enhancing the student experience through activities and facility improvements:

- Need **college trips every year** / We need a **college trip** / Need **college trips.** (Multiple requests for regular college trips)
- All is good but need to **focus on sports facilities** / All is good, **sports need more focus.** (Requests for better sports focus and facilities)

iii. Action on feedback

1. Essential Infrastructure and Hygiene

To ensure proper hygiene and cleanliness, regular cleaning of washrooms is carried out by the assigned cleanliness personnel. In addition, duties have been assigned to staff members to regularly supervise whether proper cleanliness is maintained. The cleaning is monitored and a record is maintained with the signatures of the checking staff on the day of inspection to ensure accountability and consistency.

2. College trip

The Department of Zoology organised an educational tour to Bandla with the objective of providing students with practical exposure to the rich flora and fauna of the Bandla region. During the tour, students explored the natural ecosystem of Bandla and observed various plant species, insects, birds, and other wildlife in their natural habitat. The visit helped students to understand biodiversity, ecological interactions, and the importance of conservation through direct field-based learning. Overall, the educational tour was a valuable academic experience that enhanced students' interest and understanding of zoology beyond the classroom.



3. Need to focus on sports facilities:

Improvement Based on the feedback received from students regarding the need for better sports facilities, the following actions have been taken by the college:

Approval and utilisation of funds from the Director of Higher Education: A total of **₹3,10,000** was sanctioned previously for sports equipment. In the current year, an additional **₹75,000** was allocated and utilised for the purchase of new sports equipment. Equipment purchase and focus on indoor games: The college has used these funds to purchase a variety of sports equipment, with special focus on indoor games. New equipment for indoor sports such as **chess, carrom, and table tennis has been purchased** to encourage greater student participation and to improve the sports infrastructure of the college.

Limitation of funds and phased improvement: The college currently faces a shortage of funds, due to which it is not possible to upgrade all sports facilities at once. Therefore, the development of sports facilities is being carried out in a phased manner, with gradual increases in expenditure as funds become available.
